#### Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

*Job 7:1-4, 6-7 I am filled with restlessness until the dawn.*

*Psalm 147 "Praise the Lord, who heals the brokenhearted." 1 Corinthians 9:16-19, 22-23 Woe to me if I do not preach the Gospel. Mark 1:29-39 Jesus cured many who were sick with various diseases.*

In ten days Lent will begin and we will be reminded of Jesus' sufferings, from forty days in the desert to his passion and death, but today we hear Job lamenting the tragedies that have come to define his life. His sufferings are, to him, incomprehensible. He has lost all hope. None of us suffer as greatly as Job, but we have reason to hope. The psalmist reassures us that the Lord heals the wounded and brokenhearted. Paul willingly embraces his difficulties for the gospel. Jesus places the healing of the sick and troubled at the heart of his ministry. As we listen to today's readings, let us look for hope in the Lord.
