Introduction to the Blessing of Branches

Holding our blessed palms and shouting hosannas, today we commemorate Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem. We do so with a note of melancholy, for we know that his arrival is also his entrance into the dark days of abandonment, agony, and death. However, we know that in the end God will triumph and sin, darkness, and even death will be defeated. Confident in Jesus' redemptive power, we raise our voices in love and thanksgiving.

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

Isaiah 50:4-7 My face I did not shield from buffets and spitting knowing that I shall not be put to shame. Psalm 22 "My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?" Philippians 2:6-11 Jesus emptied himself, and accepted death on a cross. Mark 14:1-15:47 The Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Today's first reading foreshadows what comes later. Isaiah's Suffering Servant continues to preach to those who are weary and hopeless despite the abuse he receives from his adversaries. Saint Paul, in the second reading, attests to Jesus' sacrifice and victory. In the Passion, we hear Saint Mark's account of Jesus' final hours before his death on the cross. Listening to the word of God today, let us echo the words of the centurion upon Jesus' death: "Truly this man was the Son of God!"
