### Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

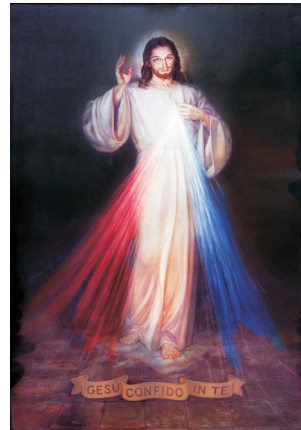
*Acts 4:32–35 They were of one heart and mind.*

*Psalm 118 “Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, his love is everlasting.”1*

*John 5:1–6 Whoever is begotten by God conquers the world.*

*John 20:19–31 Eight days later Jesus came and stood in their midst.*

Today’s Gospel features the story of “doubting Thomas,” the apostle who refused to believe in the risen Christ until he saw him with his own eyes. But let us not overlook Jesus giving the Holy Spirit to the apostles, telling them “whose sins you forgive are forgiven them.” May we be a forgiving people, calling upon the Holy Spirit, whom we received in baptism, to extend that divine mercy to all in need of forgiveness, to all of us.
