Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

Deuteronomy 4:32–34, The Lord is God in the heavens above and on earth below 39–40 and there is no other.

Psalms 33 “Blessed the people the Lord has chosen to be his own.”

Romans 8:14–17 You received a Spirit of adoption, through whom we cry, “Abba, Father!”

Matthew 28:16–20 Baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

As he says farewell to his disciples, Jesus instructs them to baptize “in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” Nearly twenty full centuries later we were baptized with the same words. God the Father, whom Moses extols in the first reading, God the Son, who calls us to discipleship in the Gospel, and God the Holy Spirit, whom Paul says bears witness to our adoption as children of God, mark our identity as Christians. We are reminded of this every time we make the sign of the cross. Listening to God’s holy word, let us reflect on the blessings we receive from the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
