Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

Ezekiel 17:22–24 I have lifted high the lowly tree.

Psalms 92 “Lord, it is good to give thanks to you.”

*2 Corinthians 5:6–10 Whether we are at home or away,
we aspire to please the Lord.*

*Mark 4:26–34 It is the smallest of all seeds, and
becomes the largest of plants.*

We hear Jesus tell two parables today, each especially relevant at this time of year when our fields and gardens teem with growing plants. To describe the kingdom of God, first Jesus compares it to someone scattering seed on a fertile field. Then he compares it to a tiny mustard seed, which grows into a huge plant. Let today’s readings sweep us away in wonder at the way God’s creation blooms.

Dispensation from Mass Ends: Bishop Daly has announced that the Bishops of Washington have decided that the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is no longer necessary. The obligation to attend Mass is to be reinstated with the Vigil Mass for Corpus Christi in June 5th. He has likewise advised that all fully vaccinated persons need not wear a mask unless they prefer to do so; and, that those who choose not to get the vaccination must continue to wear a mask when in groups.

Weekday Mass: Effective Wednesday, June 2nd, 2021, Our weekday masses will begin at 9:30 in the morning. Until further notice, Adoration will remain on Wednesday morning from 5:30; but, will close (with Benediction) at 8:30.
