Amos 7:12–15 Go, prophesy to my people.

Psalms 85 “Lord, let us see your kindness, and grant us your salvation.”

Ephesians 1:3–14 God chose us in Christ, before the foundation of the world. or 1:3–10

Mark 6:7–13 He began to send them out.

From Amos to the twelve apostles, God calls people of faith to serve others. Amos, a shepherd and horticulturist, was called to prophesy to Israel instead. Saint Paul was called to bring Christ’s message to Gentiles all around the world. The Twelve were sent by Jesus in pairs to heal the sick and drive out demons.
