Revelation 11:19a; 12:1–6a, 10ab, A woman clothed with the sun, with the moon beneath her feet.

Psalm 45 “The queen stands at your right hand, arrayed in gold.”

1 Corinthians 15:20–27 Christ, the first fruits; then those who belong to him.

Luke 1:39–56 The Almighty has done great things for me: he has raised up the lowly.
