### Liturgy of the Word

*Daniel 7:13-14 The dominion of the Son of man is an everlasting dominion.*

*Psalms 93 "The Lord is king; he is robed in majesty."*

*Revelation 1:5-8 The ruler of the kings of the earth has made us into a kingdom, priests for his God and Father.*

*John 18:33b-37 You say I am a king.*

Throughout history Jesus Christ has been acknowledged as King. Even before he was born to Mary, Daniel prophesied that one like a Son of man would come from heaven to earth and be regarded as King and Lord. The author of Revelation calls him the faithful witness of the kingdom. In the Gospel we hear him witness to the kingdom in front of Pilate. That scene gives us an insight into his kingship, which is anchored in the truth, and to which he testified during his entire time on earth.
