Liturgy of the Word

Sirach 15:15-20 There is set before you fire and water, life and death. Psalm 119 "Blessed are they who follow the law of the Lord!"

1 Corinthians 2:6–10 Eye has not seen, ear has not heard what God has prepared for us.

Matthew 5:17-37 So it was said to your ancestors, but I say this to you.

5:20-22a, 27-28, 33-34a, 37

God's law takes center stage today, as we hear ways to understand it more deeply. Ben Sira points out that we all have free will, so we can choose to obey or disobey God's commands. Saint Paul speaks of God's wisdom, which informs God's law. Jesus, the fulfillment of the law, takes four commands from the Torah and broadens each one, teaching that obeying the letter of the law is not enough. May what we hear today inspire us to live according to the spirit of God's law.

Question of the Week: When do the temptations of anger, lust, or deceit affect what I say or do? How can I build the habit of treating everyone else with honesty, mercy, and love?
