Liturgy of the Word

Deuteronomy 18:15-20 *I will raise up a prophet and I will put my words into his mouth.*

Psalms 95 *"If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts."*

1 Corinthians 7:32-35 *A virgin is anxious about the things of the Lord, that she may be holy.*

Mark 1:21-28 *He taught them as one having authority.*

Moses told the people that one day God would send a prophet from among their descendants who would speak God's word with authority. We believe that this promise is fulfilled in Jesus, who in the Gospel speaks God's word with such authority that even the unclean spirits obey him! We may be anxious about many things, to use Saint Paul's words, but let the knowledge that God can dispel the darkness in our lives give us hope.



Question of the Week: Can I identify an unclean spirit in me that seeks to destroy me? Can I find the courage to ask God to free me from this demon?
