• **Baptism:** Please contact the Deacon or Pastor, at least one month prior to desired date.

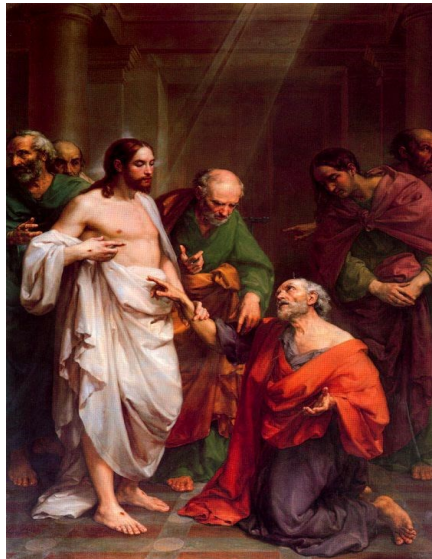
• **Sacrament of Marriage:** Please contact the Deacon or Pastor at least six months prior to desired date.
