Liturgy of the Word

Acts 9:26-31

Barnabas reported to the Apostles how Saul had seen the Lord on the way.

Psalms 22

"I will praise you, Lord, in the assembly of your people."

1 John 3:18 - 24

This is his commandment: that we may believe and love.

John 15:1 - 8

"I am the vine, you are the branches."

In the first reading, we catch a glimpse of Saint Paul (still called Saul) at a unique time. Just recently converted, he is intent on speaking boldly in Jesus' name. John tells us that believing in Jesus' name and loving one another are the ways to remain in him. Finally, we hear Jesus ask his disciples to remain in him as branches remain on a vine. 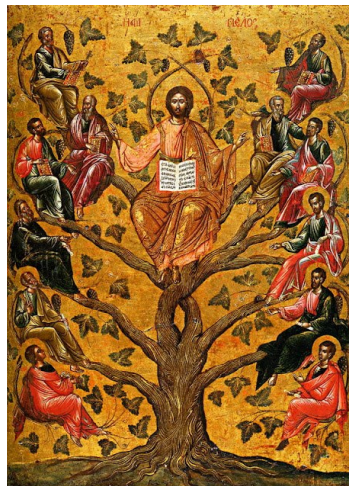
