Celebration of Life: July 13 Saturday, 1 pm, Twisp Valley Grange, Potluck style.

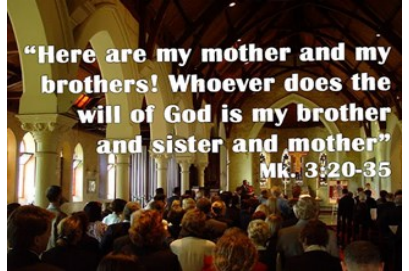
