Liturgy of the Word

Ezekiel 2:2-5 *They are a rebellious house
but shall know that a prophet has been among them.*

Psalms 123 *"Our eyes are fixed on the Lord, pleading for his mercy"*

2 Corinthians 12:7-10 *I will boast in my weaknesses, in order that the power of Christ
may dwell in me.*

Mark 6:1-6a *A prophet is not without honor except in his native place.*

Ezekiel recounts his calling in today's first reading, relating that God told him bluntly that a prophet's audience is obstinate and rebellious. Paul tells of hardships of his own but insists that they provide opportunities for Christ's power to strengthen him. The people of Nazareth take offense at Jesus, unwilling to accept that this local carpenter could teach them about God. Let us be attentive to God's voice, both here and wherever we hear it.



Question of the Week: How do I react when someone criticizes or challenges me? Do I dismiss their words at once? How can I prayerfully consider their criticism or advice?

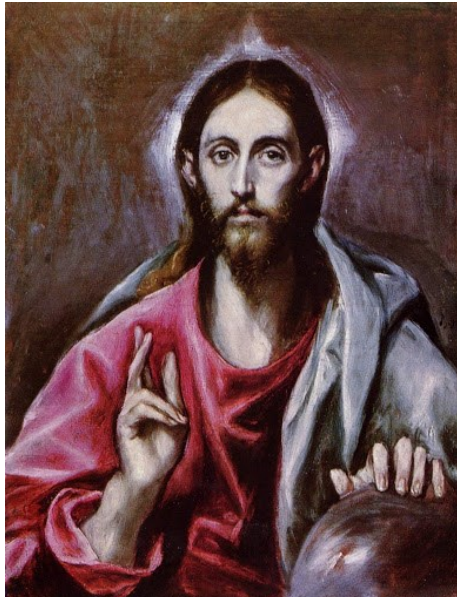
