**James 3:16-4:3** The fruit of righteousness is sown in peace for those who cultivate peace.

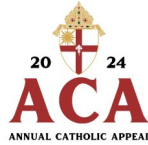
**Mark 9:30-37** The Son of Man is to be handed over . . . Whoever wishes to be first will be the servant of all.

James warns his readers that jealousy and selfishness bring conflict and even war. Jesus contrasts the contentiousness of the disciples, who were arguing about which of them were the greatest, with the innocence of a child, who does not know ambition. Let us note the self-centered tendencies in our own character and look for the antidote in today's readings.
