James 5:1-6 Your wealth has rotted away.

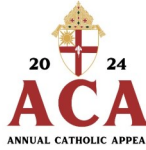
Mark 9:38-43, 45, 47-48 Whoever is not against us is for us. If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off.

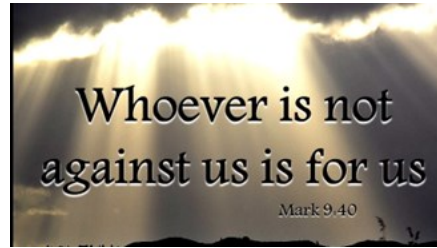


Thank you to all of you who have so generously given to the Annual Catholic appeal. We have received pledges/contributions of \$14,040
