# Liturgy of the Word

Jeremiah 31:7-9
Psalm 126
Hebrews 5:1 - 6
Mark 10:46 - 52

The blind and the lame I will bring back: I will console them.
"The Lord has done great things for us; we are filled with joy."
You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.
Master, I want to see.

Jeremiah delivers an oracle of salvation, giving his people hope that there would be an end to their exile. Hebrews points out that God called every high priest for generations, but since he was God's Son, Christ became high priest forever. Glory and wonder culminate in the Gospel, where the blind man Bartimaeus is healed by Jesus and immediately follows him on his way to Jerusalem and the cross. Wherever we are on our personal

journey, may we heed the Lord's call and follow him, like the faithful in the final verse of the psalm, who "come back rejoicing, carrying their sheaves."
