Liturgy of the Word

Daniel 12:1-3 At that time your people shall escape.

Psalms 16 "You are my inheritance, O Lord!"

Hebrews 10:11-14,18 By one offering, Christ has made perfect forever those who are being consecrated.

Mark 13:24-32 The Son of Man will gather his elect from the four winds.

Today we hear two great examples of apocalyptic literature, a style of writing that prophesies about the end of the world. Both Daniel and Jesus hope to arouse a sense of urgency if not fear in their listeners. Phrases like "everlasting horror" and "stars . . . falling from the sky" will do that! Even as we hear the many foreboding visions, let us also listen for words of hope, trusting in a God whose generosity remains unsurpassed.

Question of the Week: How do I balance the vigilance I am called to exercise in anticipation of the end of the world with the comfort I take in God's merciful presence?
