Liturgy of the Word

Isaiah 40:1–5, 9–11 God's glory shall be revealed.

Psalm 104 "O bless the Lord, my soul."

Titus 2:11–14; 3:4–7 We are saved through the bath of rebirth.

Luke 3:15–16, 21–22 "You are my beloved Son."

Isaiah heralds good news to the Jewish people in today's first reading: God will give them comfort and mercy.
