Liturgy of the Word

Isaiah 62:1–5 All shall behold your vindication.

Psalm 96 "Proclaim his marvelous deeds to all the nations."

1 Corinthians 12:4–11 The Spirit distributes gifts to each person.

John 2:1–11 Jesus transforms water into wine.

In today's first reading, Isaiah celebrates a transformed Jerusalem; what had been forsaken and desolate is now delightful and—foreshadowing the Gospel—espoused. Paul tells the Corinthians that the Holy Spirit transforms each and every one of them, though in different ways. Finally, in the Gospel, Jesus transforms water to wine, saving the newlyweds from terrible embarrassment. May we never overlook God's power to transform our lives.


