Liturgy of the Word

Isaiah 6:1-2a, 3-8 Here I am, send me!.

Psalm 138 "In the sight of the angels I will sing your praises, Lord."

1 Corinthians 15:1-11: I handed on to you what I received.

Luke 5:1-11 They left everything, even their nets, and followed Jesus...

God calls Isaiah in a vision - a vision Isaiah finds overwhelming and humbling. Once reassured, however, he volunteers to serve the Lord. Paul points out that Jesus appeared to him only after calling hundreds of disciples. Because he had persecuted Jesus'followers, he felt unworthy. Yet, he accepted this call. Finally, we hear Jesus call Simon Peter, James and John, who realized their sinfulness, but left their boats behind and followed him. May they lead us by their example.

Question of the Week: When I have felt like I was in deep water, in over my head, when doing some-thing I felt called by God to do? Did I overcome my fear or discomfort and how?
