Liturgy of the Word

Jeremiah 17:5-8 Cursed are those whose hearts turn away from God.

Psalms 1 "Blessed are they who hope in the Lord."

1 Corinthians 15:12, 16-20 Christ has been raised from the dead.

Luke 6:17, 20-26 The Beatitudes

Jeremiah warms us up for the Gospel today by speaking of whom God blesses and whom God curses. Using imagery from nature, he drives home his message: trust in the LORD. Jesus' message echoes Jeremiah's, blessing those whom society treats as outcasts and warning those who have it made by social standards. During this Jubilee Year of Hope, let us put our hope in he who has power over death itself, a hope rejected by those who live life, as Paul wrote, "for this life only."

Question of the Week: What about my life is Jesus calling me to change so that I may be blessed? If I have plenty of money, food, and happiness, what can I do to be blessed?
