Liturgy of the Word

1 Samuel 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23 David and Saul

Psalms 103 "The Lord is kind and merciful."

1 Corinthians 15:45-49 We shall bear the image of the heavenly one.

Luke 6:27-38 The measure with which you measure will be measured out to you.

Love your enemies, Jesus teaches his disciples. Bless them when they curse you, give more to them when they take from you, turn the other cheek when they strike you. Luke doesn't tell us how the disciples react, but this is a radical teaching. However, we get to see mercy practiced in the first reading, when David chooses to spare his enemy, Saul, when given the chance to slay him. Listening to today's readings, let us consider why we should choose mercy over getting even.

Question of the Week: Which is the most difficult challenge for me: turning the other cheek when I have been hurt or wronged, refraining from judging others, or giving without repayment? How will I change my thinking and my behavior?
