**Liturgy of the Word**

**Exodus 3:1-8a, 13-15** From a burning bush God promises redemption.

**Psalms 103** "The Lord is kind and merciful."

**1 Corinthians 10:1-6, 10-12** Do not grumble as the Israelites did.

**Luke 13:1-9** The just may suffer. The fruitless may get a second chance

**"I am who am." God proclaims to Moses from the burning bush.** In saying this, God claims to be existence itself—as the one who simply is. Jesus further reveals his Father in the parable we hear in the Gospel: God is prepared to cut down the unfruitful fig tree but is also willing to give it another chance to bear fruit. We sing of this aspect of God in the responsorial psalm: "The Lord is kind and merciful." Let this refrain comfort us as we hear of those who were unexpectedly and tragically struck down.

**Question of the Week:** Looking at my Lenten journey as an exodus from sin and worldly values, what specifically is holding me captive and preventing a truly new life in the risen Lord?

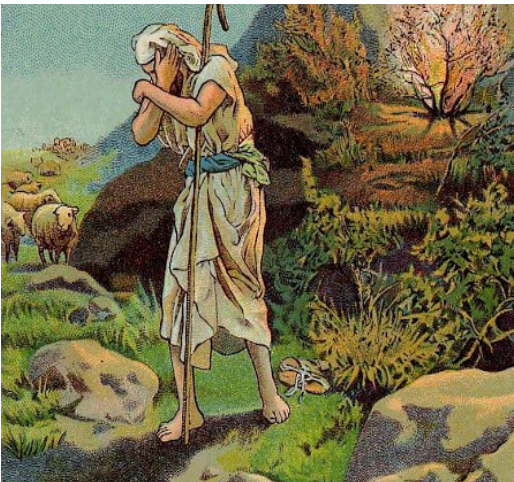
