**Liturgy of the Word**

**Acts 6:1–7**

**Psalm 33**

**1 Peter 2:4–9**

**John 14:1–12**

**A challenging issue we face today** was also faced by the early church: not enough ministers to serve all the people. We hear in the first reading that the Twelve needed more disciples willing to bring food to the needy. Peter uses the image of living stones to describe the spiritual house that is the growing church, with Christ as the cornerstone. Jesus tells his disciples of our lasting spiritual house in heaven with the Father. May the words we hear of our spiritual homes on earth and in heaven inspire us this Easter season.

**Question of the Week:** What can I do this week to know Jesus better, to serve those who are overlooked, and to prepare my spiritual home?
