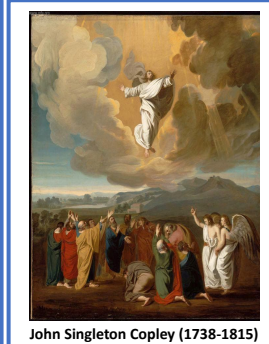
Question of the Week: How have I gotten to know God better through prayer? Will I take the time each day this week to note how prayer has changed or affected me?
