### LITURGY OF THE WORD

**Exodus 19:2–6a** God makes the Israelites a holy nation.

**Psalms 100** “We are his people: the sheep of his flock.”

**Romans 5:6–11** Through Christ we have received reconciliation.

**Matthew 9:36—10:8** Jesus summoned the Twelve and sent them out.

**The Israelites have been God's chosen people** from the time of Abraham and Sarah, “dearer to me than all other people,” as the LORD tells Moses in the first reading. In the Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples that he was sent to return “the lost sheep of the house of Israel” to the fold.
