1 Kings 19:9a, 11-13a *Elijah recognized God in the tiny whispering sound.*
Psalms 85 *“Lord, let us see your kindness, and grant us your salvation.”*
Romans 9:1-5 *Paul speaks the truth in Christ.*
Matthew 14:22-33 *Jesus walks on the sea.*

The divine presence may be heralded by loud and violent natural phenomena, but God is often found in quiet and gentle gestures. Amid fire and earthquakes, Elijah finds the LORD in a tiny whisper. During a raging storm, Peter hears Jesus tenderly inviting him to come to him. May today’s readings remind us that we may have to strain to hear God’s voice, and we may even doubt the words we hear, but we should remain aware that at any time the Lord may be calling us.
